INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS

Authority

1. This regulation is made pursuant to the *Election Law*.

Definitions

2. Unless specifically provided otherwise in these regulations, the terms used have the same meaning as defined in the *Election Law*.

“**Law**” means the *Election Law*;

“**first notice**” means the notice of election referred to in section 8 of the Law; and

“**second notice**” means the notice of election referred to in section 38 of the Law.

FIRST NOTICE OF ELECTION

Ninety days notice

3. The first notice of the general election must be
 - a) approved by the Executive Council; and
 - b) posted no less than 90 days before the election day.

Information in first notice

4. The first notice referred to in section 3 of this regulation will identify
 - a) that the election is for an election of the Tla’amin Government;
 - b) the date of the election day; and
 - c) the name and number of positions of the Tla’amin Government that will be elected during that election.

Posting of first notice

5. Not less than 90 days before election day, the notice referred to in section 4 of this regulation will be;
 - a) posted in a visible and frequently travelled location at the Tla’amin Government administration office;
 - b) published in the first Tla’amin Nation newsletter;
 - c) mailed to every eligible voter; and
 - d) published on the Tla’amin Nation website.

SECOND NOTICE OF ELECTION

Thirty days notice

6. The second notice of the general election must be
 - a) prepared and approved by the elections officer; and
 - b) posted no less than 30 days before the election day.

Information in second notice

7. The notice referred to in section 6 will identify
 - a) that the election is for an election of Tla'amin Government;
 - b) the date of the election day;
 - c) the times during which voting stations will be open;
 - d) the location of one or more voting stations where eligible voters may vote;
 - e) the name and number of positions of Tla'amin Government that will be elected during that election;
 - f) the individuals who are declared by the elections officer to be candidates for each of the positions of Tla'amin Government that will be elected during that election; and
 - g) the methods for voting at the election.

Posting of second notice

8. Not less than 30 days before the election day, the notice referred to in section 7 of this regulation will be
 - a) posted in a visible and frequently travelled location at the Tla'amin Nation administration office;
 - b) published on the Tla'amin Nation website; and
 - c) published in the first Tla'amin Nation newsletter and in every newsletter thereafter until the last newsletter prior to election day.

BY-ELECTION NOTICE OF ELECTION

9. If a vacancy occurs in the office of an elected official, notice requirements for a by-election, including timelines will not follow the same notice requirements of a general election and will be condensed.
10. The elections officer will have the discretion to identify a timeline for by-election notices in conjunction on consultation with the Executive Council.

Commencement

11. This regulation comes into force on June 23, 2016.
