



Call for Interest: CITIZENSHIP COMMITTEE

In accordance to Section 41 of the *Citizenship and Enrolment Law*, the Tla'amin Executive Council is required and authorized to appoint three (3) members to form the **Citizenship Committee**.

ROLE OF CITIZENSHIP COMMITTEE:

- determine if an applicant is eligible to have their name entered on the Citizenship Register; and
- oversee the Citizenship Registrar and direct the Registrar to enter names on, or remove names from, the Citizenship Register, as required under the law; and
- publish the eligibility criteria and the procedures to apply for enrolment, unenrolment or re-enrolment; and
- keep confidential all information provided by and about applicants for enrolment, unenrolment or re-enrolment and comply with any confidentiality requirements set out in regulations under this Law or in any other Tla'amin enactment

REQUIREMENTS OF MEMBERS OF COMMITTEE:

- be a Tla'amin Citizen in good standing with the Nation; and
- have a good understanding of Tla'amin culture, ancestry and Tla'amin Institutions.

TERM OF POSITION:

Four (4) year term that is consistent with the term of the elected government. The 2020 term will commence no later than November 9, 2020.
